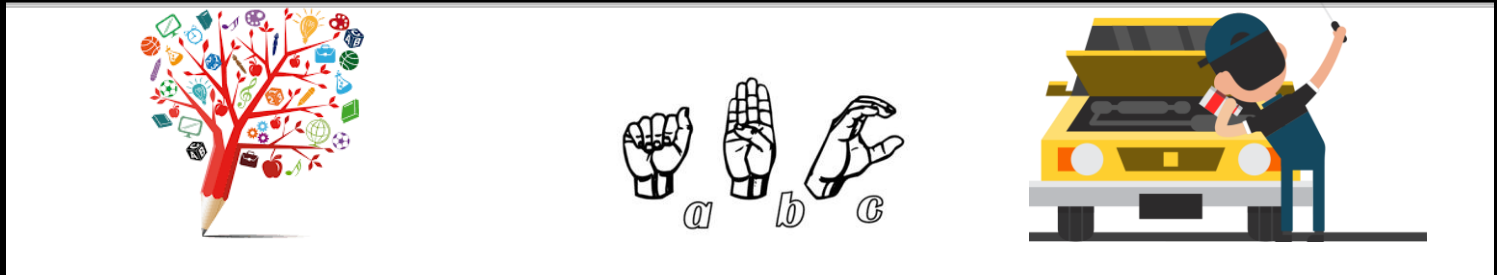

4-H Club

Location: James Morris School

Day of Week: Monday

Time: 3:30 – 4:30pm

Grade Level: K - 6

Location: Goshen Center School

Day of Week: Thursday

Time: 3:30-4:30pm

Grade Level: K-6

Summary: This is a general 4-H Club that explores many of the areas most popular to 4-H. Students will focus on expanding knowledge in STEM and have hands on activities for the students to increase their understanding of subjects. Many county and state level opportunities will be available to the youth when they participate.

4-H has deep roots in education and STEM. Students will learn valuable life skills throughout the program. Much of the 4-H curriculum is based on national standards of education. Public speaking, decision-making and analytical thinking are a big part of 4-H. (Limit: 12 students per location)

Automotive Maintenance & Modification

Location: Wamogo

Day of Week: Tuesday

Time: 2:10 – 3:10pm

Grade Level: 7-8

Summary: The course will cover basic automotive maintenance. Changing wiper blades, general vehicle safety inspections, tire rotations and more will be covered in this course. Although 7th and 8th graders do not often own cars yet, the topic will be made relevant to students who enjoy dirt bike and ATV riding. It will also be relevant to students looking to maintain landscaping equipment and other small engine powered machinery. (Limit: 10 students)

Grade Level: K-4

Summary: Loving literature together! Students will be focusing on the social side of reading starting with a read aloud each week. Students will explore the library, bookroom,

Summary: Students will work in teams to solve a mystery using *Breakoutedu* kit. They will follow clues, solve puzzles and open locks. A different, exciting, fast paced mystery will be presented each week. (Limit: 12 students)

Location: Wamogo

Day of Week: Mondays & Wednesdays (Students must attend both days per week)

Time: 2:10 – 3:10pm

Grade Level: 7-8

Summary: Students will get the training needed to obtain an American Heart Association CPR card. Skills in this class will help students be more confident in the case of an

emergency and having this certification can be a bonus when applying for jobs. A handbook is provided for each student. (Limit: 8 students)

Creative Writing

Location: Goshen Center School

Day of Week: Thursday

Time: 3:30 – 4:30pm

Grade Level: 3 - 6

Summary: This creative writing class will include experiences for sharing ideas, thoughts and descriptions through writing. Students can work independently or collaboratively and will learn about adjectives, adverbs and adding creatively to their writing.

Cursive

Location: Goshen Center School

Day of Week: Monday

Time: 3:30 – 4:30pm

Grade Level: 4 - 6

Summary: Students will have the opportunity to engage in a multi-sensory approach to cursive instruction. The program will include cursive warm-ups to facilitate an easy transition from printing to cursive. The lesson plan incorporates letter review with words and sentences. Activity pages combine handwriting instruction with paragraph, poem, composition and language art activities. (Limit: 10 students)

Digging for Dinos

Grade Level: K - 3

Summary: Students will learn about dinosaurs and their history. Students will do hands-on activities, study/find fossils while becoming Paleontologists. A dinosaur book will also be created based on student learnings. (Limit: 6 students)

Environmental Detectives

Grade Level: 3 - 6

Summary: A massive fish die-off has plagued the town of “Grey Area,” but why? Is it because of water pollution from the new fertilizer plant? Is it because of the growing amount of boats on the lake? Or is it something else? Students will work together using clues and scientific experiments to solve the crime. (Limit: 14 students)

Grade Level: K – 4

Summary: This course is all about exploring our imagination, creativity, problem solving and critical thinking skills. Students will work together on play challenges; both indoor and out incorporating engineering designed and cooperative activities – both structured and unstructured. Come join the fun!

Fairy Tale STEM: Literacy Based Math & Engineering

Time: 3:30 – 4:30pm

Grade Level: K – 6

Summary: Students will explore STEM based activities through a collection of modern empowering fairytales and folk tales starring clever and courageous girls and boys. Come dressed as your favorite character as we set out on adventures in learning science, technology, engineering, art and math! (Limit: 14 students)

Summary: Students will have open creative play prior to pairing up with a partner to work on the primary and technical theme of the day for building with instruction with a teacher. Upon completion of this activity, students with guided instruction, apply their learning to their project. The goal is to teach design, troubleshooting skills while fostering critical thinking. Students of Robotics 2 will build on their past learnings. (Limit: 20 students per location)

Sign Language – ASL Club (American Sign Language)

Art ideas will range from observation studies (like a scientist), generating paintings in various styles, collecting found objects for collage and further studies. The visual journal is a unique book to launch ideas for bigger projects to explore self.
