

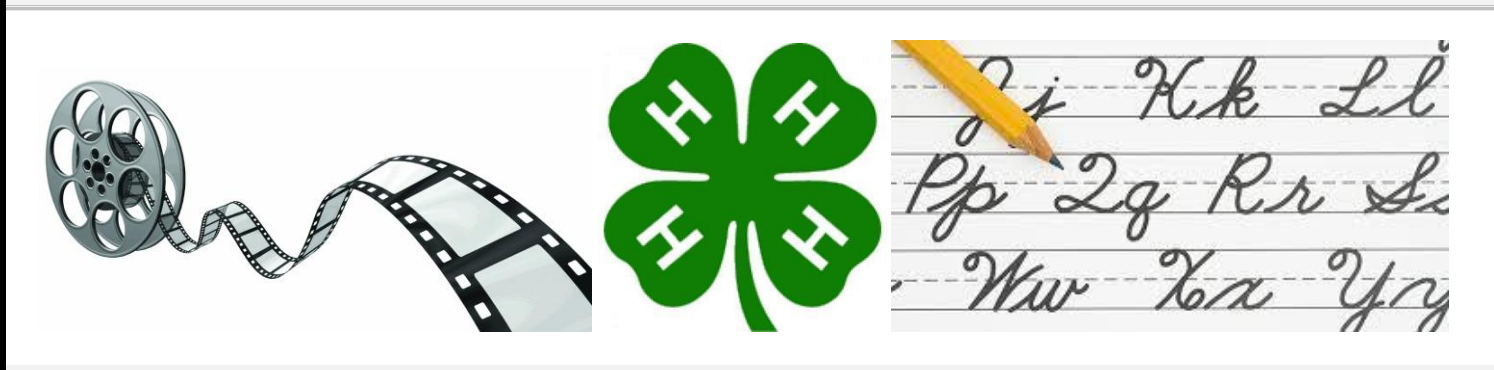

Grade Level: K - 6

Grade Level: 7-8

Summary: This is a general 4-H Club that explores many of the areas most popular to 4-H. Students will focus on expanding knowledge in STEM and have hands on activities for the students to increase their understanding of subjects. Many county and state level opportunities will be available to the youth when they participate.

4-H has deep roots in education and STEM. Students will learn valuable life skills throughout the program. Much of the 4-H curriculum is based on national standards of education. Public speaking, decision-making and analytical thinking are a big part of 4-H.

Adventure Book Club

Grade Level: 3-5

Summary: Students will read and discuss such books as *Hatchet* by Gary Paulsen or *My Side of the Mountain* by Jean Craighead George. Students will build on their reading, listening and analytical skills. There will be activities and snacks.

Summary: Learn about architecture and instruction. Apply your knowledge and creativity with a “hands on” model of your own design project. Students will learn about design concept and construction, architects and their most famous buildings. Students will learn hand drafting, scale sketching, zoning rules, codes, and 3D perspective drawing model making techniques. Students will explore new materials for cladding and construction, explore environmental design and off the grid projects.

Students will further learn about light source, mixing colors and experimentation with color, layouts of space, setting up displays to paint from and work from photos and pictures in magazine.

Summary: Students will learn the history of blacksmithing and its role in the development of our country. They will learn the basics of the tools and equipment necessary to make various projects, learn useful skills for future endeavors, whether it be for art or practical purposes. Every student will have a finished project by the end of the program. The difficulty of the projects will increase as the program progresses.

Canning

Summary: Students will learn basics of canning, making pickles, applesauce and diced tomatoes. Using their reading and math skills while working with recipes, students will assist in the process and be able to take jars of what is canned home with them.

Summary: Students will work together to learn the art of embroidery. They will learn different sewing stitches that will be used to create designs and letters. Embroidery is a creative art form that helps strengthen fine motor development and skills.

Field Hockey

Time: 3:30 – 5:00pm

Grade Level: 3-6

Summary: Students will learn and practice the basic strategies of the game of field hockey. They will participate in game situations and learn sportsmanship. The field hockey program supports the value of sportsmanship and emotional development. Learning skills and game strategies will help build confidence and peer relations as students must work together. Care for equipment and hard work help to foster these qualities.

Film 1 & 2

Grade Level: 7-8

Summary: The class will be a creative overview of what makes a film starting with historical context, the story structure and scene selection through the why's behind the director's staging, casting and other choices. Students will be made aware of what is involved in a director's and producer's filmmaking choices. The class will meet twice a week to enhance a participant's viewing pleasure and knowledge of film. Every three classes a film will be shown. A final paper on a film will be requested.

Summary: “Prepare to Discuss the World” – Students will watch a video prepared by The Foreign Policy Association and then discuss the video and share thoughts about foreign policy and current events. Students will expand their cultural awareness, knowledge of geography, and participate in discussions on the subject matter.

Harry Potter Book Club

Fundraising; brainstorming; implementing random acts of kindness; and other student driven ideas will be discussed and implemented. Students will learn what true friendship is, and how to make and be a good friend.

Knitting

Location: Goshen Center School

Day of Week: Monday

Time: 3:30 – 4:30pm

Grade Level: 4-6

Summary: Students will learn the basic methods of knitting, getting the yarn stitches on the needle, cast-off stitches and some sewing with yarn. Projects include a scarf, using various stitch patterns and a pair of mittens on the two needles. If time allows, the third project will be a small knit animal.

Screenwriting

Location: Wamogo

Day of Week: Wednesday

Time: 2:10 – 3:10pm

Grade Level: 7-8

Summary: This is an introduction to screenwriting. Each student will focus on a 10 to 15 minute short film script to be completed by the end of the semester. Aspects of this visual form of writing will be covered including correct formats, 3-act story structure, main tension, characterization, how to compose, condense and move scenes along to arrive late and leave early, along with other elements. Students will stage their work in a read-aloud script reading.

Tobacco Free Student Leadership and Advocacy Club

Summary: Students in this program through EdAdvance, will engage in some of the following activities such as produce a PSA short, participate in the Tobacco-Free Student Advocacy Leadership Summit at NVCC in November, and help plan school and community tobacco-free advocacy events.

Visual Journals

Time: 3:30 – 4:30pm

Grade Level: 4-6

Summary: Students will have the opportunity to experiment, take notes and find inspiration in an art journal. Students will explore personal interests and hobbies using various media from drawing, painting, collage and even weaving paper. Art ideas will range from observation studies (like a scientist), generating paintings in various styles, collecting found objects for collage and further studies. The visual journal is a unique book to launch ideas for bigger projects to explore self.

Wacky Wednesday

Grade Level: 1 - 3

Summary: “Wacky Wednesday” is an afterschool program where students will be read to or they will read themselves. A book, discussion and craft activity will follow. The students will prepare their own wacky snack. Wacky jokes and riddles will be told during the snack time. Wacky games will be played on some Wednesdays.

Woodworking

Summary: Students will have the opportunity to learn basic woodworking and safety skills. They will complete a project; start to finish.

Zentangles

Grade Level: K-6

Summary: Zentangles are a relaxing form of artwork that combines patterns, designs, and symbols to create a two-dimensional structural artistic image. No prior artistic ability is required to be successful in this course. Using just black pen and smooth paper, participants will explore strategies for creating zentangles and will leave the course with at least one piece that is ready to be framed for home or a gift!
